Boating & Recreation

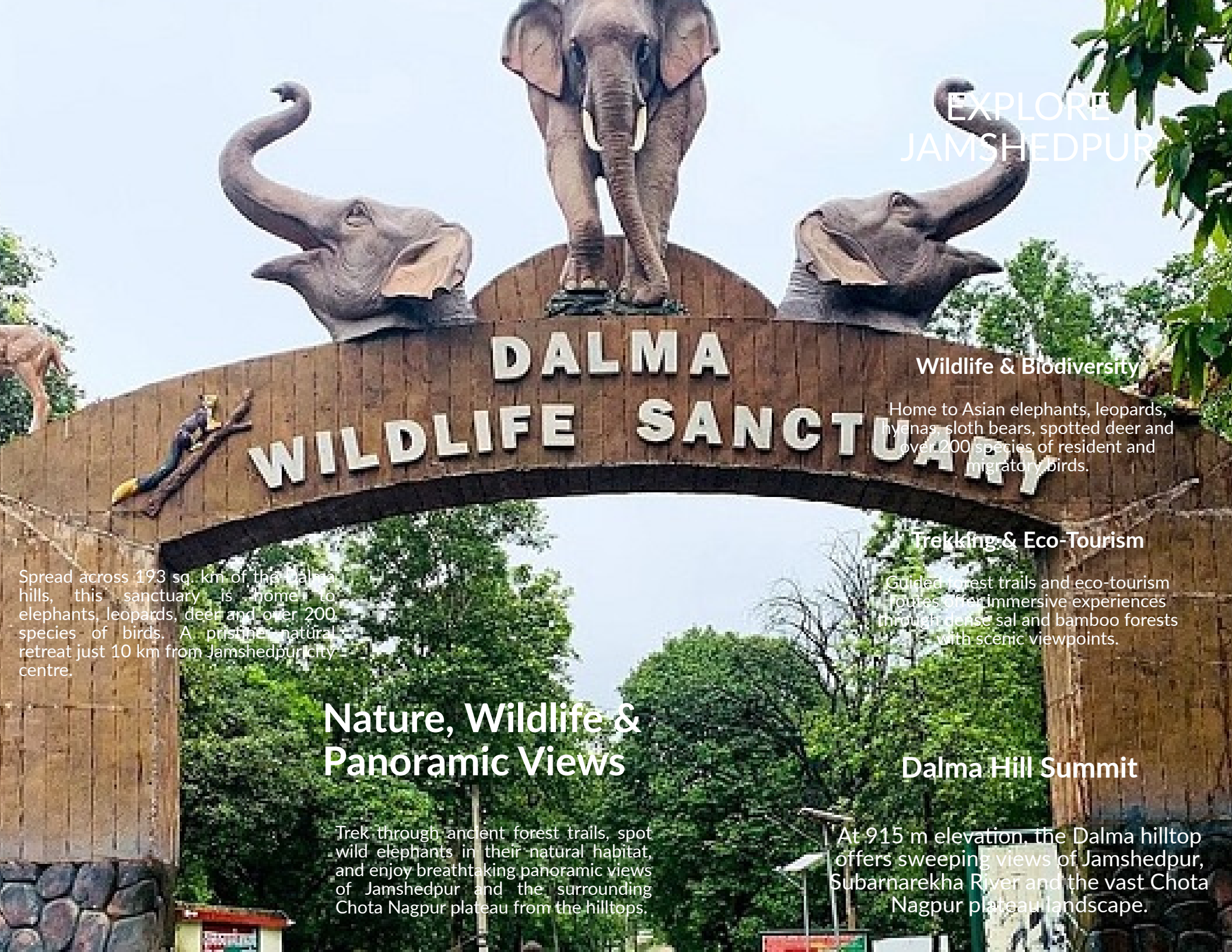
Enjoy peaceful boating on the calm waters of Dimna Lake, surrounded by the scenic Dalma hill ranges.

Guided forest trails and eco-tourism routes offer immersive experiences through dense sal and bamboo forests with scenic viewpoints.

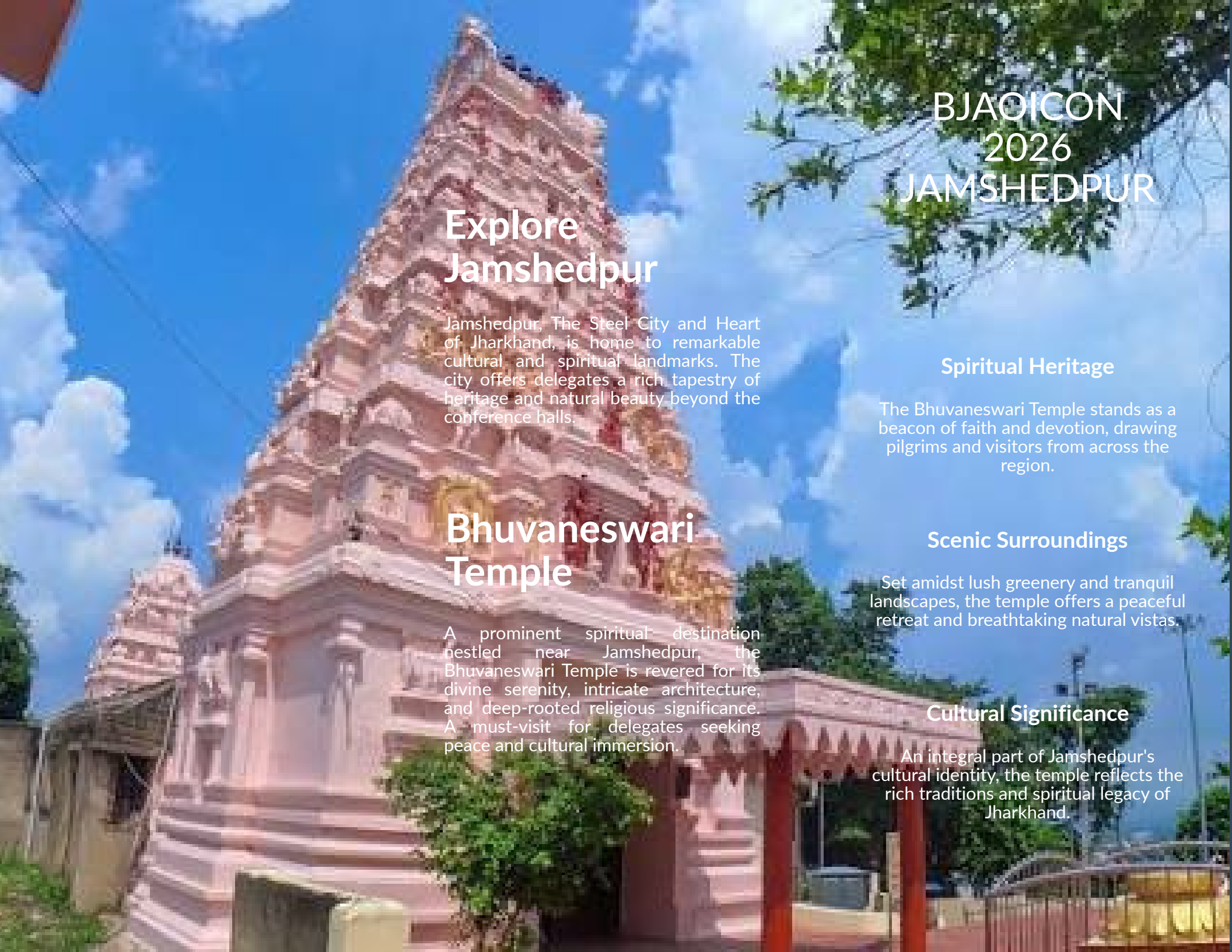
Nature, Wildlife & Panoramic Views

Dalma Hill Summit

At 915 m elevation, the Dalma hilltop offers sweeping views of Jamshedpur, Subarnarekha River and the vast Chota Nagpur plateau landscape.

Spread across 193 sq. km of the Dalma hills, this sanctuary is home to elephants, leopards, deer and over 200 species of birds. A pristine natural retreat just 10 km from Jamshedpur city centre.
